Vancouver Campus

BENEFITS OF UNIVERSITY TRANSFER PROGRAM

- Upon completion of 24 credits, high school grades are no longer evaluated for admission.
- Upon completion of the first-year English course, English proficiency requirements for transfer are met.
- Save on tuition fees - fees are 30~50% lower than public universities.

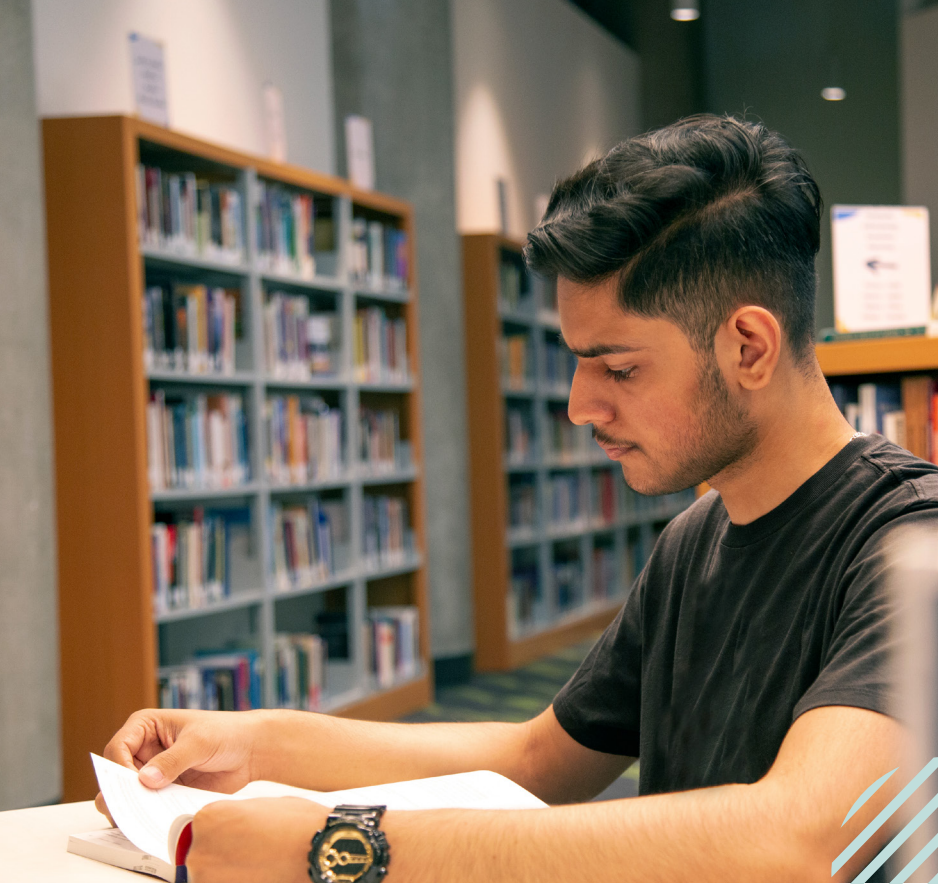

The Associate Degree program is a foundational degree consisting of 60-64 credits, typically completed over a 2-year period. The program provides a comprehensive learning experience that also allows students to customize and focus their coursework in an area of personal interest.

Course Code Description

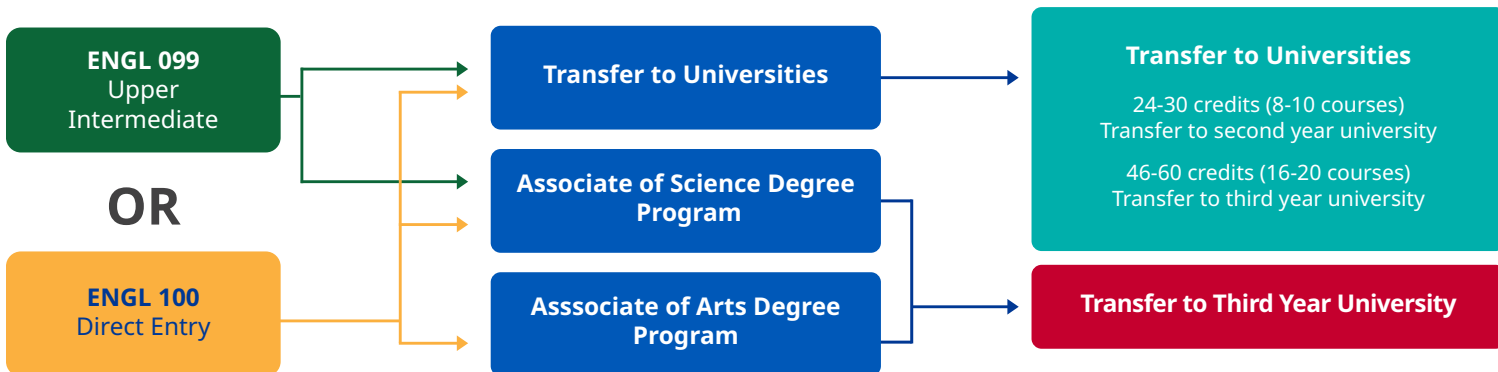
ENGL 099 English Academic Preparation: Advanced

This course is designed to improve a student's English language skills to prepare them for the university and college classroom. Therefore, this course focuses on improving listening, speaking, writing, and reading for the university classroom, specifically research, essay practice, citations and improving note-taking skills. Vocabulary lessons focus more on academic English rather than idioms, slang, and phrasal verbs.

Students who intend to pursue post-secondary studies in Canada may also begin to enrol for college and university level courses while enrolled in the EAL program.
