<p>S = Survey</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Introduce the reading (author, title, general contents)• Provide a brief summary• How is this reading important to the course I'm taking?	
<p>Q = Questions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• What are the main points of what I am reading?• Why are these points important?• What does this content say about the subject I'm studying?• Are there important key terms people should know?	
<p>1R = Read</p> <p>Take notes on main points</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Information from the reading to support main points• Interesting points?	

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Your analysis:<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Do you agree or disagree with points in the reading?-Can you add any of your own ideas?-Do you have any questions or suggestions?	
<p>2R = Remember</p> <p>What should people remember from this reading?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-Key terms, people, concepts etc.	
<p>3R = Review</p> <p>Sum up the main points of the reading, and how it relates to your class</p>
