Main points to remember:

- English proficiency can be demonstrated by the completion of 3 units of university-level English (certified "W").
- Quantitative requirement may be met with the completion of a course that transfers to SFU as a "Q" course.
- Economics is a Program Major offered through the Faculty of Arts.
- **Transfer students must first apply for Admission to SFU's Faculty of Arts, and then submit a separate application to the Economics Major once they have completed 30 credits, including ECON 201 at SFU with a C- or higher.**
