- Nexis Uni is an excellent resource for COMM and other research assignments that require news articles




## RESOURCE TYPES

- There are different types of company information available as well: company profiles, financial or analyst reports, company news, etc.






### **DISCOVER TOPICS**

- 'Discover Topics' lets user search for trending topics in business, criminal justice, and political science
- Searching within a subject works the same way as general search but offers different filers such as searching by company name or stock ticker
- Each subject provides a list of key, trending topics that can be used as research topics
- Each subject provides a collection of related sources, including news articles, legal opinions, and blog posts
