WHAT TO EXPECT: ENTERING CAMPUS

TEMPERATURE CHECKS

All students will be required to undergo temperature checks at one of our health and safety tables located at each entrance to the campus.

MASKS

WHAT TO EXPECT: ON CAMPUS

DESIGNATED ZONES

The Student Lounge, Student Den, and Multi-Purpose Rooms (240-241) can be used for **eating and drinking.** Beverages with lids are permitted in classrooms, but masks must be worn at all other times.

BARRIERS

Plexiglass barriers will be used for all student appointments.

HYGIENE

Students are expected to wash their hands regularly and use hand sanitizer at our sanitization stations, located conveniently around campus.
