## WHAT TO EXPECT: ENTERING CAMPUS

### TEMPERATURE CHECKS

All students will be required to undergo temperature checks at one of our health and safety tables located at each entrance to the campus.

### MASKS

# WHAT TO EXPECT: ON CAMPUS

## DESIGNATED ZONES

The Student Lounge, Student Den, and Multi-Purpose Rooms (240-241) can be used for **eating and drinking**. Beverages with lids are permitted in classrooms, but masks must be worn at all other times.

## BARRIERS

Plexiglass barriers will be used for all student appointments.

## HYGIENE

Students are expected to wash their hands regularly and use hand sanitizer at our sanitization stations, located conveniently around campus.
