## WHAT TO EXPECT: ENTERING CAMPUS

#### **TEMPERATURE CHECKS**

All students will be required to undergo temperature checks at one of our health and safety tables located at each entrance to the campus.

#### MASKS

### WHAT TO EXPECT: ON CAMPUS

#### **DESIGNATED ZONES**

The Multi-Purpose Rooms (240-241) can be used for **eating and drinking.** Beverages with lids are permitted in classrooms, but masks must be worn at all other times.

#### BARRIERS

Plexiglass barriers will be used for all student appointments.

#### HYGIENE

Students are expected to wash their hands regularly and use hand sanitizer at our sanitization stations, located conveniently around campus.
