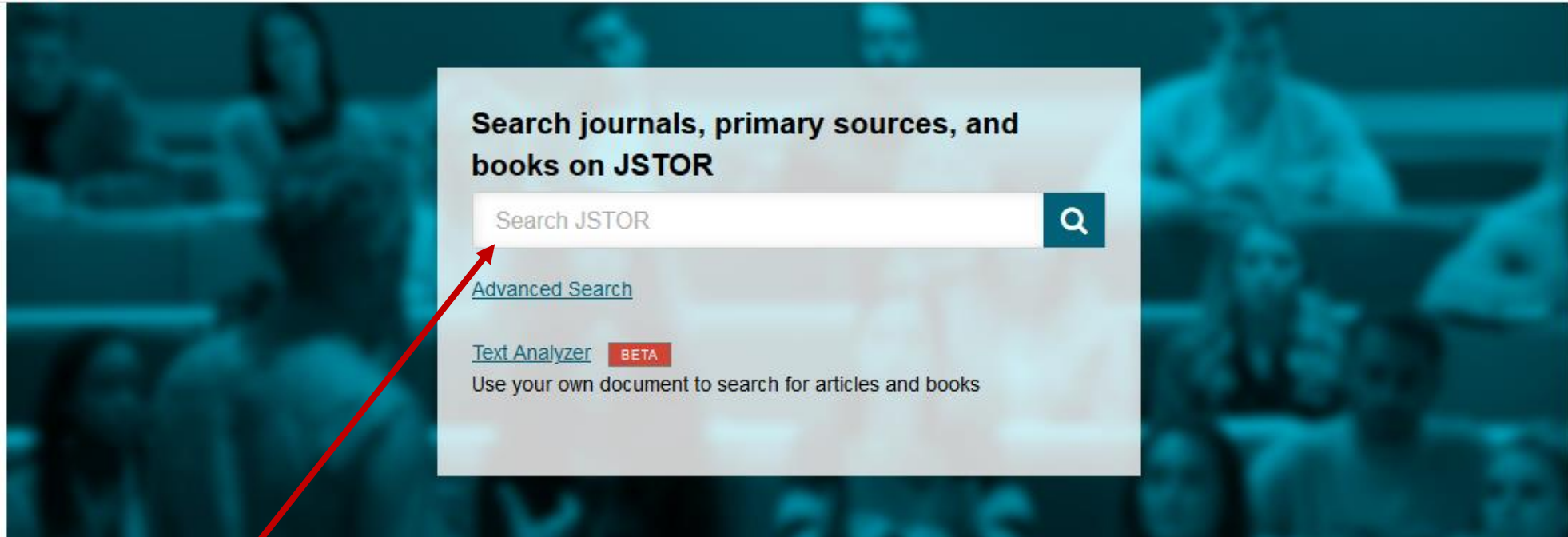

Interchange: The War of 1812

Introduction by Nicole Eustace

Centennial anniversaries provide unique opportunities for commemorating the past while characterizing the present. In some cases anniversaries may remind us of things we would rather forget—a point that is especially true when the date in question marks a war. Of all wars in American history, the War of 1812 enjoys the dubious distinction of being the one least likely to be remembered. In a freewheeling conversation, the contributors to this interchange have tried to determine why the War of 1812 in North America has so often been a forgotten conflict and whether or not that situation needs to be remedied. At its bicentennial, does the memory of the war deserve to be exhumed or should all discussion of the conflict be buried once and for all?


Considering the war from a variety of analytical and geographical angles, these historians debated whether people in the United States often fail to remember the conflict because it was inconsequential or because the memories it evokes are uncomfortable. Was the war popular in its day but insignificant in history, or were its effects important but ultimately unpalatable? How does the war look different when viewed from varied cardinal directions: south from Canada, north from the United States, west from Britain, or east from Indian country? In what areas—from economics to politics to diplomacy to society and culture—should the impact of the war be measured?
