- Have I closed other programs and websites that are not required for the exam?
- Camera and mic on?
- Zoom virtual background off?
- Cell phone off?
- Bathroom break? (No bathroom breaks allowed during the exam. If you leave the room, your exam is over.)
- (Open book exams only) Notes and/or textbook at hand?
- If Canvas is slow to load, clear web browsers cache



DURING the exam, I will

- 📙 Do my own work
- Use only instructor approved materials
- Not use my cell phone or other irrelevant devices
- Avoid writing with multiple browsers
- Only ask my instructor or invigilator if I have a question
- Not communicate with anyone else in any way (No talking, texting, messaging!)
- Focus on the exam and not appear to be cheating
- Not copy directly from my textbooks, Powerpoints, materials etc
- Not look up or copy from other online sources
- Cite paraphrased or summarized information
- Be responsive when my instructor/invigilator communicates with me
