HISTORY

Established in 2006 under the British Columbia Ministry of Advanced Education, Alexander College consists of two urban campuses. These campuses are located in Burnaby and Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada.

Alexander College first offered University Transfer and English for Academic Purposes programs. From the beginning, we have designed our programs to help first- and second-year undergraduates achieve success in their transition to the post-secondary environment.

This success is facilitated by strong student support and readily available services.

2006

In 2006, Alexander College was approved to offer the Associate of Arts Degree and was later approved to offer the Associate of Science Degree in 2011. We are continually adding specialty Associate Degree concentrations for both Arts and Science.

2009

Inaugural Batch of Graduates

2020

On March 16th, 2020, in concert with all BC post-secondary institutions, Alexander College pivoted to offering all courses virtually due to the Covid-19 pandemic. In addition to offering all courses online, student academic and support services also transitioned to being offered online.

2021

In August 2021 we moved to a larger campus in Burnaby with improved facilities and services. The original plan to open the campus for full face-to-face operations in the Fall 2021 term was compromised by the continuing Covid pandemic.

ABOUT OUR TRADITIONS

Alexander College Crest

The Alexander College Crest depicts the breathtaking coastal landscape of Vancouver, British Columbia. The background features the dramatic Coast Mountain range, Pacific Ocean, and rising sun, all designed to represent the natural beauty of the College's location.

In the center of the shield, the capital 'A' represents Alexander College standing strong above our natural landscape, the land in which we teach.

Above the shield, a crimson Roc (legendary bird of prey) holds a scroll with the inscription Alexander College and is symbolic of the namesakes of the founders of the institution.



Alexander Mackenzie

Alexander College is named for Alexander Mackenzie, the Scottish-born fur trade adventurer and author who made an arduous overland journey from the east to reach the Pacific Coast at Bella Coola on 22 July 1793.

As the leader of the first expedition on record to cross the North American continent in Canada or the United States, he has a special place in Canadian history.

Mackenzie was ahead of his time in the vision he articulated of an organized trade between Asia and North America via the Pacific.

It is in the spirit of his achievement and vision that Alexander College honours his name.

Academic Stoles

In honour of Alexander McKenzie and the Scottish ancestry of British Columbia, in 2019, Alexander College introduced two official colours for our academic regalia.

The yellow stole for Associate of Arts in Science symbolizes intellectual curiosity and the pursuit of scientific exploration. It reflects the brightness of knowledge and discovery that our graduates have embraced throughout their academic journey.

The white stole for Associate of Arts represents the diversity of disciplines encompassed by this general degree, honoring the broad academic achievement of our graduates across various fields of study.

Honor Cords

Alexander College has always taken pride in recognizing our students' academic achievements. In that spirit, we are pleased to introduce a new tradition to honor exceptional students who achieve a percentile of 97 or higher in their graduating class.

During the convocation ceremony, these students will be presented with a prestigious Honor Cord, which is a gold cord on their stoles, symbolizing their excellent academic dedication and achievement. This tradition serves to inspire and motivate students while recognizing and celebrating their remarkable accomplishments.

The instructors mentioned below are the ones that stood out and received the most votes, they will be presented with an award at the Convocation Ceremony, to commemorate their achievements.

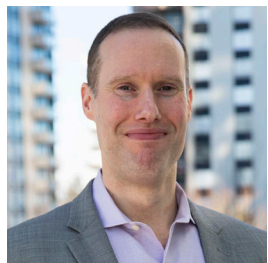
Instructor Appreciation Awards



Azadeh Khoshaein (MA)

Instructor, Economics

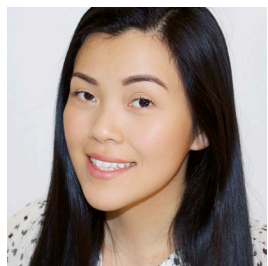
Azadeh Khoshaein has an MA in Economics from SFU and began teaching Economics at Alexander College in Fall 2011. Azadeh is among AC's longest-serving instructors and is now in her thirteenth year at the college. Her students comment on the energy and knowledge she shares in every class. Azadeh's students say "I appreciate my professor's story-telling and passion for life . . . she gave me a greater understanding of the connections [between world economies and our daily lives]." Dr. Chris Hyland (PhD)

Instructor, History

Chris Hyland holds a PhD in Canadian History from the University of Calgary and has taught History at Alexander College since Fall 2019. His students say: "Professor Hyland is a really great man. . . but Chicago style is very difficult!" Chris's students add that he's their "favorite instructor because he explains everything with great clarity." Students also say that Chris makes them feel included in classroom activities, that his grading of assignments and exams is fair, and that he makes helpful suggestions on how to improve. It's also worth noting that Chris Hyland has performed a leading role in Indigenizing our curriculum at Alexander College, providing important information and guidance for our students and faculty. Dr. Anthony John Frederick Griffiths

Dr. Anthony Griffiths is Professor Emeritus in the Faculty of Science at the University of British Columbia. His professional specialty is genetics, in which he has published numerous research papers.

He has been President of The Genetics Society of Canada, and Secretary General of the International Genetics Federation.

For many years he was on the Board of Directors of a non-profit foundation that worked to increase knowledge about science to parents and elementary school teachers in British Columbia and Alberta.

They created a successful workshop programme that traveled around BC and Alberta for about 20 years. Dr. Griffiths edited and co-authored a book on teaching elementary school science distributed to all elementary schools in BC. "KidScience: Real science your child can do" won a BC Book award in 2000.

He taught third year genetics at UBC for 35 years and is the co-author of books on undergraduate genetics, wildflower genetics, popular genetics, and genetics teaching.

He is also the senior co-author of a successful genetics textbook (first published in 1975), which has been translated into many different languages and is currently used in universities around the world. By next year, which will see the publication of the 12th edition of "Introduction to Genetic Analysis", the textbook will have been in print for 50 years.
